Until 2007, Salvador was the home of the Estádio Fonte Nova that had been erected in 1951 but was demolished and has been re-erected in recent years. The Arena Fonte Nova of today is a modern stadium with a roof made of light metal; it can accommodate 56,000 people. The entire complex houses not only the stadium but also a panoramic restaurant, a football museum, shops, hotels and a conference centre.
